Application Procedure:

The candidates will fill in the Application Form only through **online portal** (www.debracollege.ac.in). The applicants have to fill in the form with the personal details, academic details and have to upload the scanned copy(s) of all the Marksheets, photo and signature. As per order of the Govt. of West Bengal (Ref No. 507-Edn (CS)/10M-95/14, Dated: 30th June 2022). There is no application fee.

The eligible applicants have to fill in the forms for admission to Post-Graduate and other Programmes with their Percentage (%) of Marks (Part-I, II & III) obtained in UG (Honours) course in annual system. In case of semester system, applicant have to fill equivalent percentage of marks corresponding to their CGPA obtained as per the rule fixed by their home institution.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- a.* Online provisional admission will be done based on the merit list and category wise availability of seats published through the university admission portal.
- b.* For admission to different Programmes, an SC or ST candidate getting admission should have obtained marks [UG (Hons)/PG marks, which are applicable] not lower by 25% of that marks obtained by the last candidate of the UR Category. In case of OBC-A and OBC-B the candidates getting admission should have obtained marks [UG (Hons)/PG marks, which are applicable] not lower by 10% of that marks obtained by the last candidate of the UR category. In any case, if a candidate obtained marks lower than the minimum qualifying marks prescribed by the university / appropriate authority for admission to the relevant Programmes, he/she will not be eligible for admission.
- c.* All the provisionally admitted candidates are required to be present and to produce all the originals of uploaded Certificates, Mark Sheets and testimonials at the time of **physical verification of admission**.
- d.* The physical verification of testimonials & other documents for provisionally admitted students will be held in the concerned department by the appropriate bodies when students will be asked to report for their offline classes in the Campus.
- e.* Application forms if not properly filled in and accompanied with attested copies of the documents are liable to cancellation.
- f.* Admission will be cancelled if the original documents are not found in conformity with the declaration in the forms submitted online.
- g.* If at any stage it is found that a candidate has concealed, suppressed or distorted any information/fact in the application form, his/her admission shall be summarily cancelled.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The students passed out in the year 2021 and 2022 are only eligible for admission to the following Post-Graduate & other Programmes for the academic session 2022-23.

ADMISSION PROCESS

1. Preparation of Merit List for the students of Vidyasagar University(VU) [Vidyasagar University and its autonomous colleges] [80% Category: 80% of total seats]

1.1. The admission of the Vidyasagar University (VU) students (80% category), the merit list will be prepared in the following manner.

- (a) UG (Hons) final percentage of marks (Part-I, Part-II & Part-III taking together) in case of annual system. OR
- (b) UG (Hons) equivalent percentage of marks converted from CGPA, in case of semester (CBCS) system.

1.2. In case of a tie, marks obtained in the immediately preceding Examinations are to be considered for ranking.

2. Eligibility Criteria for Vidyasagar University(80% Category)

Honours in relevant subjects (as mentioned in point B)

3. Reservation for Vidyasagar University (80% Category)

3.1 Reservation policy will be considered as per Govt. order 906 Edn/Estt dated 18.09.1997. The category wise percentage (%) of reserved seat is as follows: SC-22%, ST-6%, OBC-A-10%, OBC-B-7%. Fraction of 0.5% or more will be rounded to the next whole number.

3.2 **5% of each category** will be reserved for **differently-abled** candidates. Merit list will be prepared on the percentage of disability. In case of non-availability of **differently-abled** candidate, the seat reserved for **differently-abled** candidates of the particular category will be converted to that Category only.

3.3 1% of total seats of all PG Programmes are reserved as Sports/ Culture quota.

3.4 Prize holders at International/National/State representation in the last two years will be considered for Sports Quota provided that he/she has participated in the Inter College Competition/ Inter College Athletic Meet organized by our university in his/her tenure in UG level. The sports events are Football, Volleyball, Athletic, Yoga, Khokho, Kabadi, Chess and Table Tennis. A committee will be constituted to assess the performance of the applicants in the respective field.

3.5 Prize holders in the International/National/State meets in the last two years will be

considered for Cultural Quota provided that he/she has participated in the Inter College Cultural Competition organized by our university in his/her tenure in UG level. A committee will be constituted to assess the performance of the applicants in the respective field.

3.6 The number of seats in the particular subjects will be reduced by the number of candidates selected for Sports/Culture Quota in that subject. The number of seat will be reduced from the particular category (UR/Sc/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B) in which he/she belongs.

4. Preparation of Merit List for Other University students (20% Category:20% of total seats):

4.1. The admission of the **Other University students (20% category)**, the merit list will be prepared in the following manner.

(a) UG (Hons) final percentage of marks (Part-I, Part-II & Part-III taking together) in case of annual system. OR

(b) UG (Hons) equivalent percentage of marks converted from CGPA, in case of semester (CBCS) system.

4.2. In case of a **tie**, marks obtained in the immediately preceding Examinations are to be considered for ranking.

5. Eligibility criteria for Other University students (20% Category):

The minimum marks required for admission of **Other University students (20% Category)** is as follows:

Arts & Commerce and Science:

(a) All Subjects except Commerce, Economics, Hindi, Sociology, Electronics and Microbiology:

45% marks in Hons. (for UR Candidates)

40% marks in Hons. (for SC / ST/ differently-abled /OBC-A/OBC-B Candidates)

(b) Commerce, Economics, Hindi, Sociology, Electronics and Microbiology: 40% marks in Hons.

6. Reservation for Other University students (20% Category)

6.1 Reservation policy will be considered as per Govt. order 906 Edn / Estt dated 18.09.1997. The category wise percentage (%) of reserved seat is as follows: SC-22%, ST-6%, OBC-A-10%, OBC-B-7%. Fraction of 0.5% or more will be rounded to the next whole number.

6.2 **5% of each category** will be reserved for **differently-abled** candidates. Merit list will be prepared on the percentage of disability. In case of non-availability of differently abled candidate, the seat reserved for **differently-abled** candidates of the particular category will be converted to that Category only.

The following documents have to be brought by the provisionally admitted candidates at the time of physical verification

1. Print out of the online filled in Application Form with a passport size coloured photograph affixed in the box provided in the Application Form.
2. Self-attested photo copies of all the Mark sheets of Examinations passed (10th onwards), University Registration Certificate.
2. Self-attested photo-copy of the Admit Card/ Certificate of H.S. or equivalent /Madhyamik as evidence of the date of birth.
3. Self-attested photo-copy of SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ differently-abled certificate (/s) issued by the appropriate authority, for those applying under respective quota.
4. Self-attested photo-copies of the Certificate of Games & Sports/ Cultural Competition (International/National/ State in the last two years), for those applying under respective quota.
5. Migration Certificate (for other university candidates only) must be submitted within two months from the date of admission.
7. Self-attested copy of Aadhar Card.
8. All the originals of above documents (2 to 7) required to verify.
