An applicant who passed H.S. (10+2) level in (2021, 2022 & 2023) with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in the subject or related subject is eligible to apply for 4 Year BS./B.Sc. (Hons) Programme with Major in Science according to the rules of Vidyasagar University.

## **Admission Criteria:**

Admission criteria, In-take capacity etc. shall be governed according to the guidelines issued by the Government of West Bengal and Vidyasagar University as applicable time to time. Proposed basic admission criteria applicable only for UG Admission for session 2023-24 with respect to introduction of CCFUP are as follows:

- ✓ Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council are eligible for admission in the undergraduate programmes with Single Major and Multidisciplinary Studies under CCFUP within 3 (Three) consecutive academic sessions from the date of passing the qualifying examination.
- ✓ Candidate passing Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) from Vocational stream conducted by the respective Board/ Council for vocational studies or any other equivalent board/council are eligible for admission in the undergraduate programmes in Multidisciplinary Studies only within 3 (Three) consecutive academic sessions from the date of passing the qualifying examination.
- ✓ Candidate must have passed in 5 (Five) recognized subjects (excluding Environmental Studies) including at least one language subject in the qualifying examination.
- ✓ Students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination with minimum 45% marks in the Aggregate (to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in 'Best Five' subjects excluding Environmental Studies) along with pass in the subject/related subject or 50% marks in the subject or related subject are eligible to apply for admission in the Single Major (Honours/Honours with Research) programmes.
- ✓ Students carrying pass marks in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination with at least pass in five subjects (excluding Environmental Studies) are eligible to apply for Multidisciplinary Studies only under CCFUP.
- ✓ Other UG admission criteria regarding merit point calculation and subject/programme specific requirements shall be same like previous as applicable.

## **CALCULATION OF MERIT POINT**

- Merit Point will be calculated by adding the 10% of aggregate with the marks obtained in the subject for which Honours is sought. In case of the subjects like Pol. Sc., History and Philosophy, if the subject is not studied in the H.S., marks of Language (Whichever is highest) will be added to the aggregate.
- For Merit Point calculation, aggregate will be calculated by adding the marks obtained in the best five subjects.
