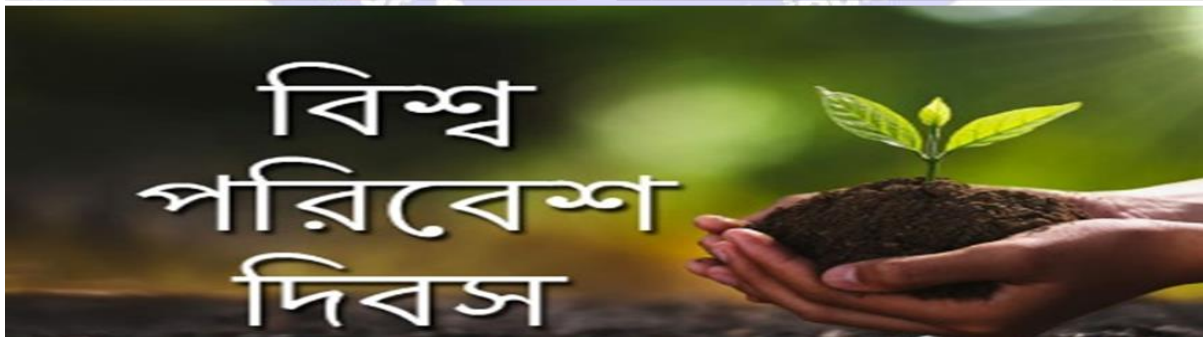

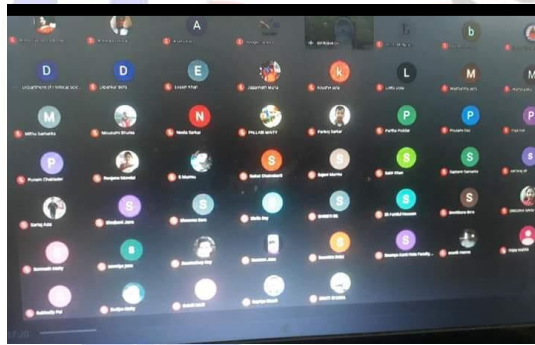
"Indian Democracy at work" 12th January, 2021
